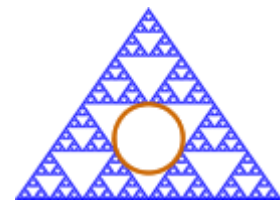

The Mathematics Master's Program is part of the Mathematics Teacher Leadership Center (TLC), an integrated partnership of universities and school districts to improve mathematics achievement in middle, secondary, and post-secondary education in the northern Rocky Mountain region. The Center also offers a mathematics teacher leadership program and engages in research to produce evidence-based contributions to the mathematics teaching and learning knowledge base. The TLC is funded by a \$5million, 5 year grant from the National Science Foundation.
